PALLIATIVE HOME CARE

Palliative Home Care aims to improve the quality of life of terminally ill cancer patients, by providing medical and psychosocial support to patients and their families, in their homes.

NCSMSB home care team comprises fulltime nurses and a volunteer doctor trained in palliative care. Palliative Home Care service is only available to patients living within a 20km radius from NCSMSB office.

Once registered, the team will visit the patient at home for an initial assessment, before further management plans are discussed with the family.

LOAN OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT

As many patients on palliative care also require various equipment to make them more comfortable, NCSMSB lends out medical devices such as hospital beds, ripple mattresses, commode chairs, wheel chairs, oxygen concentrators etc. to our patients.

These equipment are either bought by the Society using government grants or are donated by the patients' families and the general public.
